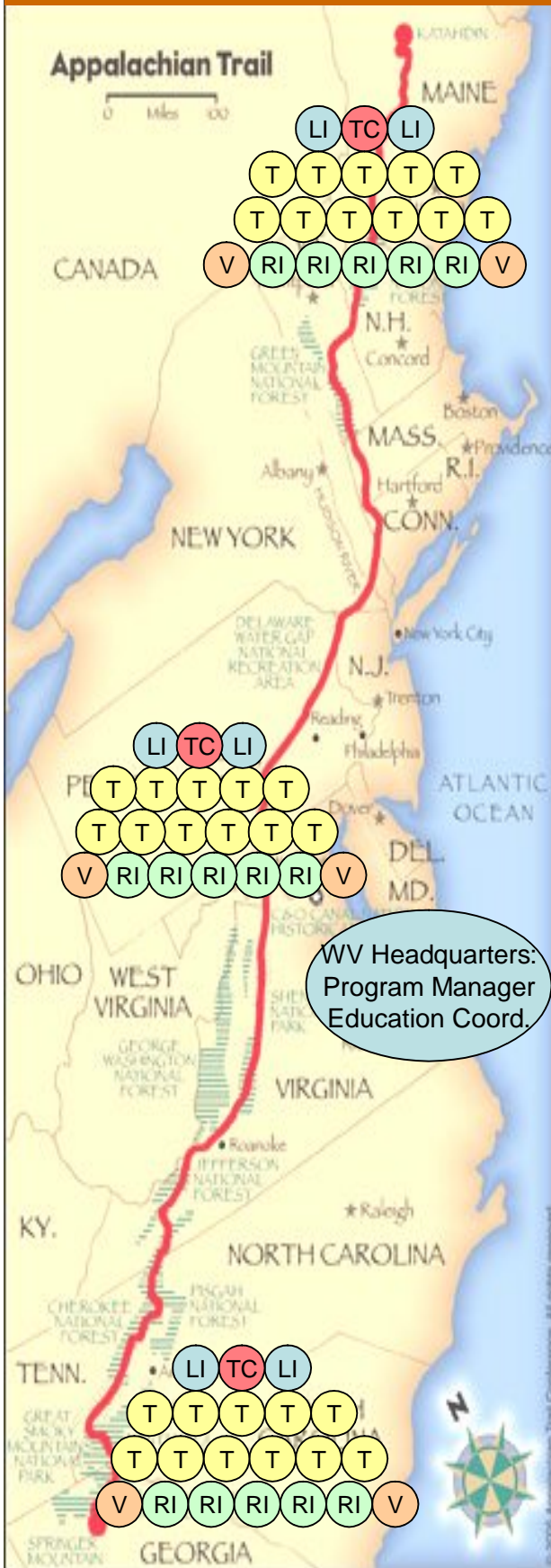


A TRAIL TO EVERY CLASSROOM Program Model

A Place-Based Education & Service-Learning Professional Development Program

1. Train-the-Trainer: (TC) (LI)

A Team Captain and Lead Instructors will be recruited from partner clubs and agencies within the New England, Mid-Atlantic and Southern regions of the Trail. These core instructional teams will attend a 21/2 day Train-the-Trainer workshop.

2. Participant Recruitment: (T) (V)

Each regional instructional team will recruit 10-12 teachers from target locales. A core recruitment strategy is to encourage teachers to come as pairs from the same school and/or district in order to support each other's efforts. Two trail club volunteers will be recruited as participants to build capacity in our affiliates and serve as liaisons between teachers and clubs as curriculum evolves from development through implementation.

3. Local Workshop Series & Summer Institute: (RI)

A local 2-day introductory workshop will be held in the spring, followed by a central 41/2-day summer institute and local workshops in the fall and winter. Resource Instructors will be brought in for specific sessions. This year-long professional development series will be offered for graduate credit through Shepherd University.

4. Learning Networks:

Team Captains will hold quarterly conference calls with the Program Manager and Education Coordinator. Instructional Teams will meet annually and share best practices as a refined Train-the-Trainer series. Teacher and club support is ongoing.
